To apply for a PhD, you must submit:

1. **Covering Letter** - *You should detail why you feel you would be an appropriate PhD Student for PML.*
2. **Full CV**
3. **Two Full References**
4. **Eligibility Status and Equal Opportunities Form.** - *Download from [here](#)*

Your application must indicate the reference number PML2018/22 followed by the Project Title and Number

NB - we do not require you to complete an application form.
